Appointed by the Church of God International Executive Committee at the 2024 General Assembly as Administrative Bishop of Southern New England, Bishop Doyle P. Scott, Sr., comes to the office having served as International General Council Board, Administrative Bishop of Minnesota, International Director of Intercultural Advancement Ministries, as International Director of Black Ministries; Regional Administrative Bishop of Southern New England; State Administrative Bishop Florida Cocoa; State Evangelism & Home Missions Director Florida-Cocoa and Pastor of New Beginnings of Hope; Dominion Worship Center; Faith Memorial, Daytona Deliverance Worship Center and Resurrection Life Fellowship.

Bishop Scott is the first person of African descent to serve in three States/Region as Administrative Bishop and to crossover and serve in a state where no individual of African descent has never served.

Bishop Scott earned a Doctorate in Divinity from Emerson Theological Institute, a degree in Biblical Studies from Logos Theological College, a Licentiate from Overstone Theological College and a Bachelor's degree in Divinity from Canada Theological College. He also holds designations as a Certified Victims Advocate, Church Consultant and Community Service Chaplain. Bishop Scott received an Honorary Doctorate degree from St. Thomas University.

Bishop Scott labors in ministry with his wife, Reverend Linda. They are the proud parents of three children, LaNekka, Doylesa and Doyle Jr., and have two grandchildren Rayneisha & Doyle III.
